

Quick Guide to the NIH Compliance Training Video

Once you are informed that your NIH-funded research paper will be published, there are important things you need to know that are covered in the section entitled, “Things to Consider Before Submitting Your Manuscript Using NIHMS”. (02:55 to 06:43)

1. Has the publisher already submitted the manuscript for you?
2. If the manuscript has been submitted by the publisher, what does the author need to do to make sure it’s approved?
3. If the publisher has not submitted the manuscript, which version of the manuscript will the journal allow the author to use for public access?
